Preclinical: If the student receives a <u>FAIL</u>; or a <u>CONDITIONAL</u> grade,

If a student receives a FAIL (F) grade, the student remediates the entire block.

The fail (F) grade remains on the student's transcript.

 If the student receives 1 or more Fail (F) grades, the student will go before the Medical Student Evaluation Committee (MSEC). If the student receives a CONDITIONAL (CN) grade, the student remediates the necessary portion(s) of the block:

• the student can **REMEDIATE** the necessary portion(s) of the block, and the CN grade will become a PASS, if the student passes the relevant remediation assessment(s) on their first attempt. If the student fails the remediation assessment(s), the CN grade becomes a permanent Conditional FAIL (CNF).

Separately, this policy only applies if a student did not sit for the initial assessment as scheduled. In this case, the student will receive a CN grade and if the student passes the relevant remediation assessment, the CN grade will become a Conditional Pass (CNP). If the student fails, the CN grade will become a permanent Conditional Fail (CNF).

Clinical: If the student receives a <u>FAIL</u>; or a <u>CONDITIONAL</u> grade,

If a student receives a FAIL (F) grade, the student remediates the entire course.

The fail (F) grade remains on the student's transcript.

If the student receives a CONDITIONAL (CN) grade, the student retakes the necessary portion(s) of the course:

- If the student fails the *NBME shelf exam*, the student will receive a temporary CN grade and be allowed:
 - RETAKE ATTEMPT #1 = If the student passes this retake attempt, the CN grade will become a
 permanent PASS; If the student fails this retake attempt, the student is allowed an additional
 retake attempt;
 - **RETAKE ATTEMPT #2** = If the student passes this retake attempt, the CN grade will become either a permanent Conditional PASS (CNP) or a Conditional FAIL (CNF), if the student fails this retake attempt.
- If the student received a CN for the clinical portion of the course, the student must **REMEDIATE** the clinical portion of the course and the CN grade will become a permanent Conditional PASS (CNP) or Conditional FAIL (CNF), depending on if the student passes or fails respectively.

IMPORTANT TO NOTE:

- The MD Registrar will be/must be notified when a preclinical and/or clinical student receives either a failing and/or conditional grade
- Conditional grade changes will be/must be submitted to the MD Registrar through the Grade Change Form (Grade Form 2300-GC)
