<b>WHO</b>	MFA patients, MFA employees	Patients seen for another reason, at discretion of provider	GW students, housestaff (residents, fellows) and faculty	Non-MFA patients, MFA patients if IPC is over capacity
<b>WHY</b>	Any reason (symptomatic pts, pre-op clearance, occupational, travel)	To guide same-visit decision-making (e.g. albuterol nebs)	Campus testing, <b>occupational exposure<sup>2</sup></b> , return-to-work clearance	Any reason

<b>WHAT TEST</b>	Rapid antigen PCR	Rapid antigen (Quidel QuickVue)	PCR	Variable
<b>TURNAROUND</b>	rapid: 20 min PCR: 1-2 days	20 minutes	1 day	Variable
