Internal Medicine Clerkship - 8 weeks\*\*

Pediatrics Clerkship - 8 weeks\*\*

OBGYN Clerkship - 6 weeks

Surgery Clerkship - 8 weeks\*\*

Primary Care Clerkship - 4 weeks plus longitudinal component \*\*

Psychiatry Clerkship - 6 weeks

Intersession – 1 week plus individual days

#### **Clinical (Transitions to Advanced Clinical Practice)**

Acting Internship (Medicine, Surgery, Pediatrics, GW ICU, or Family Medicine) - 4 weeks

Emergency Medicine or Pediatric Emergency Medicine - 4 weeks

Neuroscience - 4 weeks (may be taken in year 3)

Transitions - 4 weeks

Intersession – 1 week plus individual days

Free Choice Electives - spanning clinical years 3 & 4 - 26 weeks\*\*

Anesthesiology - 2 weeks (may be taken in year 3)
