

## Requirements for Neuroradiology Fellows\*

- 1) Interpretation of at least 3000 Neuroradiological examinations, including CT and MRI, of which at least 1500 are Neuroradiological MRI cases
- 2) Interpretation of at least 250 non-invasive vascular examinations (including computed tomography angiograms (CTA), computed tomography venogram (CTV), magnetic resonance angiogram (MRA), and magnetic resonance venogram (MRV))
- 3) Participate and document at least 100 image guided procedures, including catheter-guided angiography and fluoroscopically guided lumbar punctures
- 4) Present one lecture to residents and/or medical students
- 5) Submit at least one scientific paper or exhibit for presentation at a regional or national meeting
- 6) Plan and participate in a QI project
- 7) Completed advanced cardiac life support training and certification at the beginning of fellowship
- 8) Present at least one didactic lecture to other trainees describing own research
- 9) Attend and participate in one local and /or regional extramural conference
